Performance

The performance lasts approximately 55 minutes with no interval.

Lights and sound are operated by toured personnel. Both operating positions must have a clear view of the stage.

Sound operating position is required. The position cannot be behind glass or in a control box. Please hold off auditorium seats to facilitate this if necessary.

Get-in & get-out

The get-in depends on the set up of the theatre. The set-up of the scenography can take 2 hours if the theatre has a sufficient grid for hanging the elements. If we have to make a grid using stands and such, the setup of scenography takes longer, approximately 5 hours. The light and sound set up take another 5 hours, making the total get-in time between 7 and 10 hours. The get-out takes 3 hours; however, it can take longer if we bring our own equipment.

There must be a rehearsal before the performance.

The venue will need to provide a minimum of 1 skilled technician for get-in and get-out, 1 specialized in sound, and 1 in lighting. Both should be competent at rigging/hanging set parts.

Staging and Technical Requirements

Stage and Set-Up

- A black box stage is required
- A full black out is required
- The performance requires raked seating
- The height should be at least 3,5 m

For a large venue:

- Maximum stage size of performing surface is 1100 cm (width) x 700 cm (depth)
- Additional min. 2,5 m width of space on the left side of stage (or backstage) for storage of props
- 7m x 7 m size of white dance floor
- 4 m x 7 m size of black dance floor
- 3 m height of pipes for hanging backdrop
- 3 m height of pipes (perpendicular on backdrop) for hanging scenery on left side.

For a small venue:

- Minimum stage size of performing surface is 900 cm (width) x 500 cm (depth)
- Additional min. 2,5 m width of space on the left side of stage (direct access to backstage) for storage of props
- 7 m x 5 m size of white dance floor
- 2 m x 5 m size of black dance floor
- 3 m height of pipes for hanging backdrop
- 3 m height of pipes (perpendicular on backdrop) for hanging scenery on left side

The staging items we bring with us:

- White Polyethylene (LDPE) Backdrop in 3 pieces (total width 7 m, height 3 m)
- White Polyethylene (LDPE) sliced curtains in 12 pieces (total width 5 m 7 m, height 3 m)
- 7 m x 5 m/ 7 m x 7 m Whyte Polyethylene (LDPE) flooring

Items provided by venue

This performance requires:

• Disco ball

If the show is traveling internationally, it also requires:

- White plastic chair Monoblock
- White clothes horse with wings
- Black stretch foil (width 50 cm)

Lighting

Lighting control and reflectors provided by venue:

- 20x PC 1 kW + Frost
- 6x Profile ETC Zoom or 50°
- 1x Flood 1 kW (+barndoors!)
- 28 fixtures
- (20 channels)
- + audience light

We bring our own filters.

Sound

Sound equipment provided by venue:

- Soundcraft SI-impact (mixing console)
- L R (Master) + 2x active speakers
- 1x Microphone + stand for microphone.

Please note that a front of house operating position is required. Please hold off auditorium seats to facilitate this if necessary.

Dressing Rooms

Please provide:

- Two dressing rooms for the actors (1 male, 1 female). These should be nonsmoking and private.
- Showers with hot water
- Tea and Coffee are desirable
- 1 x Crate of 500ml Still Water

• If providing meals please note a number of company members are vegetarian.

Timetable, Transport and Contact

Set up takes between 7 and 10 hours, depending on what the venue provides. Take down is 3 hours.

Scenography travels with VW Crafter.
